## 1.) PIPE MAKING WORKSHOP

Friday April 7

9 am - 4 pm

Fee: \$100

Start off your visit to TAPS by making your own pipe at our pipe making workshop hosted by Liberty Arts Sculpture Studio (918 Pearl Street, Durham, NC), and sponsored by Vermont Freehand. Taught by local artisan pipe makers David S. Huber, of DSH Pipes, and John Inge, the workshop will focus on the process of pipe making from start to finish. Experience working hands on with common tools of the trade including a professional grade sand blasting system. You will receive instruction and guidance from David and John every step of the way. At the end of the workshop you will leave with a pipe of your own creation! During lunch, tour the fabrication facility at Liberty Arts and meet the artists that make up this vibrant Durham community. Or, check out some of the great tooling available from Vermont Freehand.

**Fee includes pipe kit, breakfast, and lunch.**

- 2.) Also on Friday the 7<sup>th</sup> there will be a sponsored tobacco social from 5:30 to 9:30 PM at the Ramada Inn across Blue Ridge Road from the Fairgrounds. As anyone who was there last year can tell you, it was a wonderful time of meeting friends, old and new. There will be complimentary hors d'oeuvre, wine, and beer. Please join us.
- 3.) Raleigh has become a tourist destination for almost 1/2 million visitors a year. While Raleigh cannot compete with the Las Vegas' "strip" or the New Orleans' French Quarter, it has a remarkable number of museums and fine restaurants as well as unique attractions all within 10 minutes of the Fairgrounds. These include an arts district, hand-carved basswood carousel, and a world-class art museum campus which is dog and bicycle friendly.
